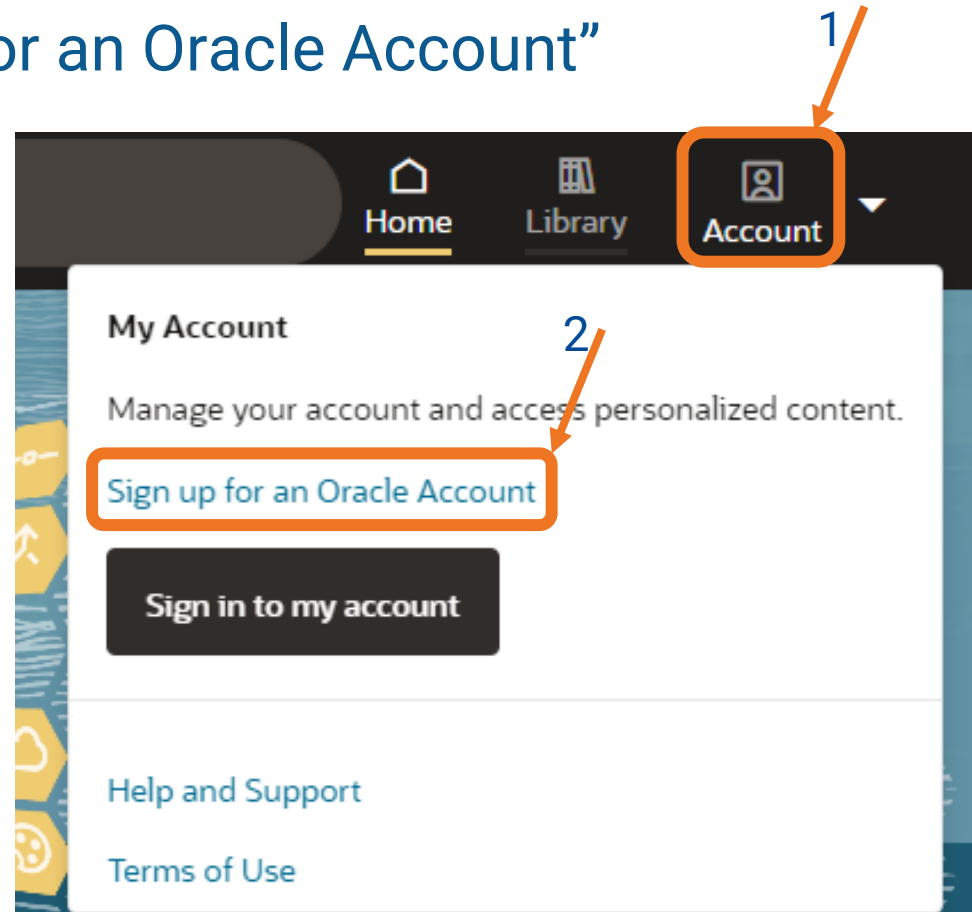
- Effective September 1, 2022, Oracle University will be delivering all Oracle exams through its own learning and exam delivery platform, MyLearn.

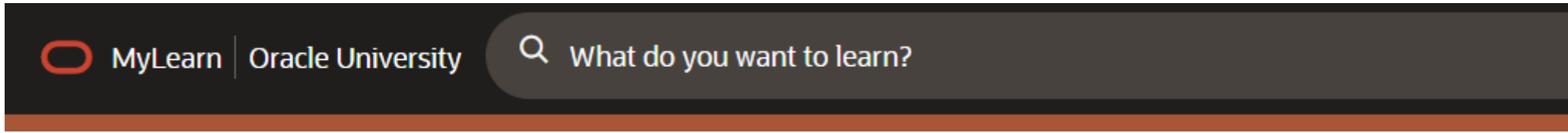
After successfully creating an account, go to <https://mylearn.oracle.com/home>

- Sign into your account

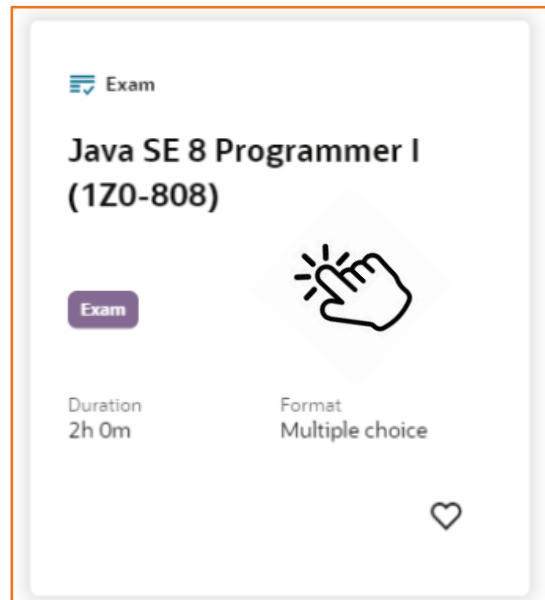


Choose your exam
